CAMPS have been really effective for the kingdom this summer.

We have run seven Camps this season and one week we had three Camps running simultaneously. The Leaders testify to experiencing the Lords overruling and keeping in many situations.

We did have a serious accident that involved Lisa a leader on the Horse trek camp receiving kick from a horse that broke ribs in two places puncturing her lung. This resulted in an air ambulance transfer to Hospital where she stayed for the next six days. But praise the Lord, she continues to make good recovery with no lasting disfigurements or disabilities. Do pray for her health over the winter as the flu could could progress into a serious lung infection.

It has also been encouraging to receive a number of thank you notes from Campers and Parents.



Other fantastic news is that Council have been able to make an appointment to our recently advertised **Ministry Manager position**. We are excited to announce that **Martin and Corina Eldershaw** have accepted this position and plan to be here late autumn. Martin is presently a self employed builder. Corina is a home mum to their infant daughter Giselle and has journalist and insurance qualifications. Martin has been involved in Kids ministries in his home church and sees this as a natural progression to be more involved in these ministries while reducing his trade involvement. It was also encouraging to hear them talk of this position as a ministry to be involved in rather than a job to pay the bills.



The CYC Council have stepped out in faith viewing this position as absolutely necessary if we are to provide a well organised, vibrant and relevant Christian ministry to the young people of our area. We are also looking to the Lord through His people to provide for the remuneration of this new initiative and would be delighted with increased **financial support**. For those who feel called/burdened to partner with us in this I have attached a automatic bank payment form. All we need is for everyone on the mailing list to up their contribution by twelve dollars per month (or four dollars a week) and we are there. So will you prayerfully consider assisting us in making it happen.

Our **OSCAR** approval is still a work in progress! An audit of our facility and policies commenced during the Adventure Camp. That part seemed to proceed favourably and due to time constraints the audit was suspended. Presently we having our staff records reviewed. A lot of importance is placed on this aspect of the audit as evidence is sought that we have safe and qualified staff to run our programmes. Do pray that we receive a satisfactory report and approval from this process.



FAMILY CAMP for 2008 has been cancelled as I have not been able to have things in place with sufficient lead time to make it happen. However we plan to run family camp in 2009.
