

About Family Camp

CYC conducts this camp in the belief that the Old and New Testament Scriptures are fully inspired, wholly trustworthy and infallible revelation of God; the final authority in all matters of faith and practice.

This camp is open to all families and those who desire fellowship, discussion and a deeper grasp of the historic faith of the Scriptures. Children will have their own programme during the morning lectures. It is anticipated that teenagers will attend all meetings. An afternoon activity may be arranged.

Limited accommodation is available to those who attend as a family in Cabins and bunkrooms. There are caravan points, or the local camping ground may be used.

The CYC Council expects campers to attend all meetings, fully support the camp programme and happily observe Camp rules. You will be expected to assist with camp duties. There will be afternoons free for family activities.

There is no fixed charge for the camp. Those who attend are asked to share in responsible stewardship with the costs involved. Unattached teenagers attending camp need to formally enrol, be under the direct supervision of a parent or other responsible adult at camp.

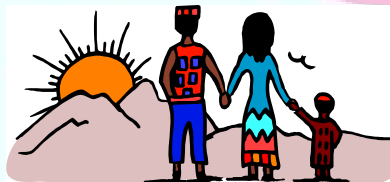
