Activity Leader Requirements

Any competent adult who has been given instructions from a member of CYC staff can run this activity

Ratio

1 adult to 10 children

Participant requirements

Weather appropriate clothing

Must wear shoes

Not have had a head injury (including concussion) in the previous 3 weeks

Activity Leader Instructions

Complete a risk assessment as per the Continual Risk Assessment section of the CYC Waihola Activity Management Plan Give safety/instruction briefing

This will cover the following:

- Only ten persons on each piece of equipment within the Team Initiative Course
- When the equipment is wet certain parts of the course (especially the wooden surfaces and tyres) can be slippery

Equipment

The team initiative course is a permanently installed group of structures.

Blindfolds

Reasons to end activity

If at any point the activity can no longer be run safely

Activity Maintenance

Paid staff inspection of the activity every 12 months to identify any new hazards/wear and tear and sign off on safety of activity. If staff deem there to be any insufficiencies that increase the risk to an unsafe level, the activity will no longer continue until the risk is remedied or eliminated.
